Bootlace - AL Conductor Installation Guide


Smear conductive grease into the bootlace barrel and ensure that the whole inner surface is covered.



Select the correct bootlace as per the recommendation table.

 Carefully strip the cable with same length as bootlace barrel.

Avoid nicking or cutting conductors.



Carefully insert conductor into the end of the barrel. Do not twist the conductor.



Use bootlace crimper to crimp the bootlace barrel.

It is optimal to crimp the middle of the barrel,
ensuring that the crimp face is not too close to the
bootlace insulation or barrel end.
Apply suitable ALI-FLEX® G03 Glue Lined Heatshrink
to complete the crimping.
